2009 TISAC Table Tennis Tournament – Final Report

On Monday, February 23, 2009, Wells International School hosted the 2009 TISAC Table Tennis Tournament at the Wells International School – On Nut Campus. There were two (2) divisions competing at the tournament: a Primary Division (Under 13's) and a Secondary Division (Over 13's).

In the Primary Division, the participating schools were:

- Wells International School
- Kessinee International School
- Charter International School
- Regent International School

However, due to a glitch in the communications channels, along with a week off from school, the team from Regent could not make it the tournament.

Pool play for the Primary Division began at 12:10pm, with team members from each school evenly distributed into four (4) pools of three (3) players each. Pool play ended at 12:45pm with the all three schools having players advancing into the tournament bracket. The quarterfinals of the tournament bracket began at 12:50pm and the final, gold-medal match ended at 1:20pm.

Results for the Primary Division were as follows:

- Team Championship Trophy – Wells International School
- Individual Gold – Toby (Gr. 5), Wells International School
- Individual Silver – Trevor (Gr. 5), KIS International School
- Individual Bronze – Andy (Gr. 4), Wells International School

In the Secondary Division, the participating schools were:

- Wells International School
- Bangkok Christian International School

Since there were only two schools represented, both teams fielded eight (8) players, with team members once again evenly distributed into four (4) pools of four (4) players each. Pool play started a bit late at 3:20pm and ended at 3:50pm. Both schools had players advancing into the tournament bracket which started at 4:00pm. The secondary gold-medal match was the longest of the day, requiring a sudden-death third game to decide the champion.

Results for the Secondary Division were as follows:

- Team Championship Trophy – Bangkok Christian International School
- Individual Gold – Tint (Gr. ?), Bangkok Christian International School
- Individual Silver – John (Gr. 8), Wells International School
- Individual Bronze – Hye Sung (Gr. ?), Bangkok Christian International School

For both divisions, individual winners were given medals to take home. For the team champions, trophies have been presented, but the name plates are being made and are expected by Monday, March 1. Once the name plates are added to the trophies, they will be delivered to their respective schools.

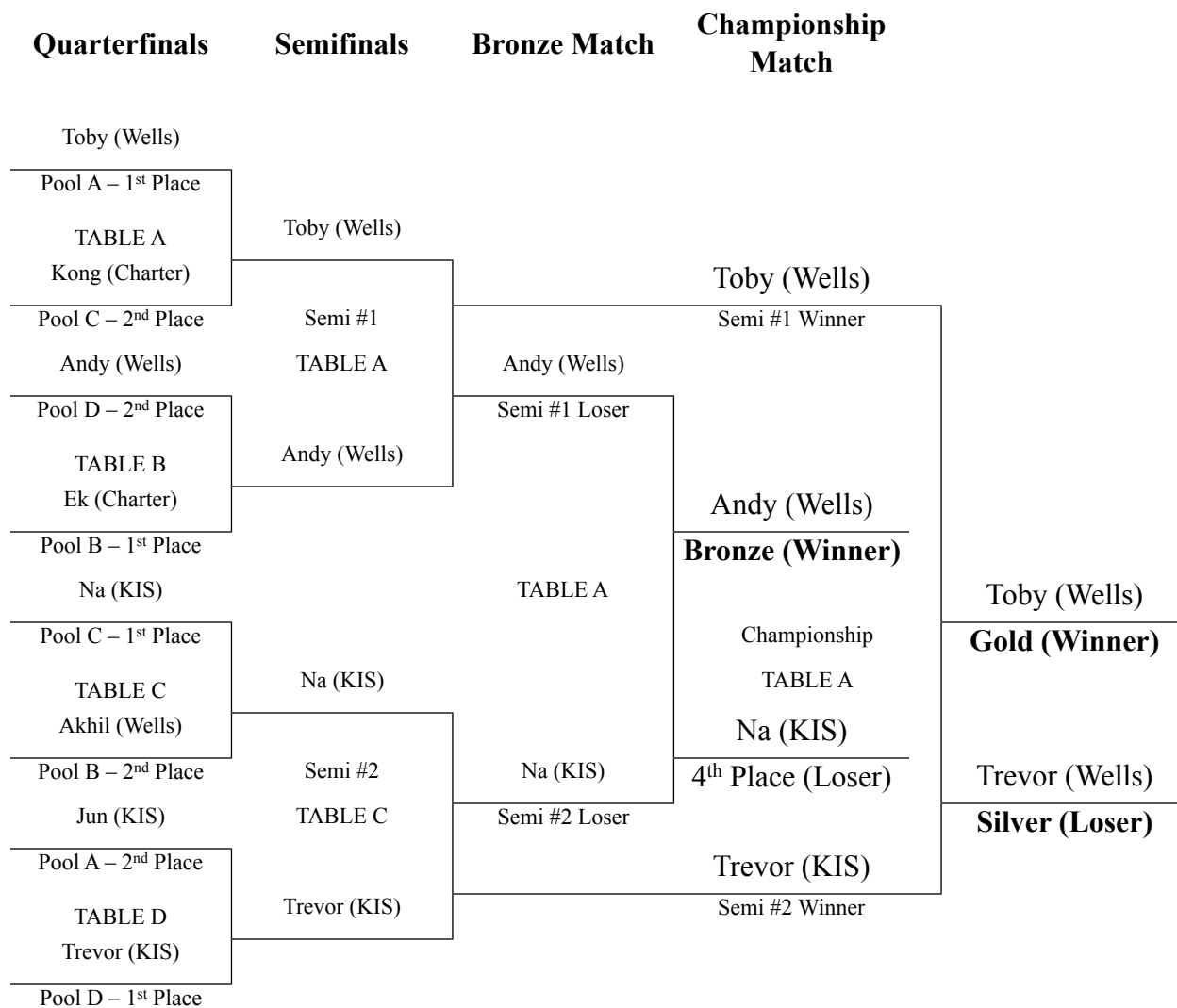

2. Bronze Medal Match and Championship Match is best of three games to 11 points, with deuce.

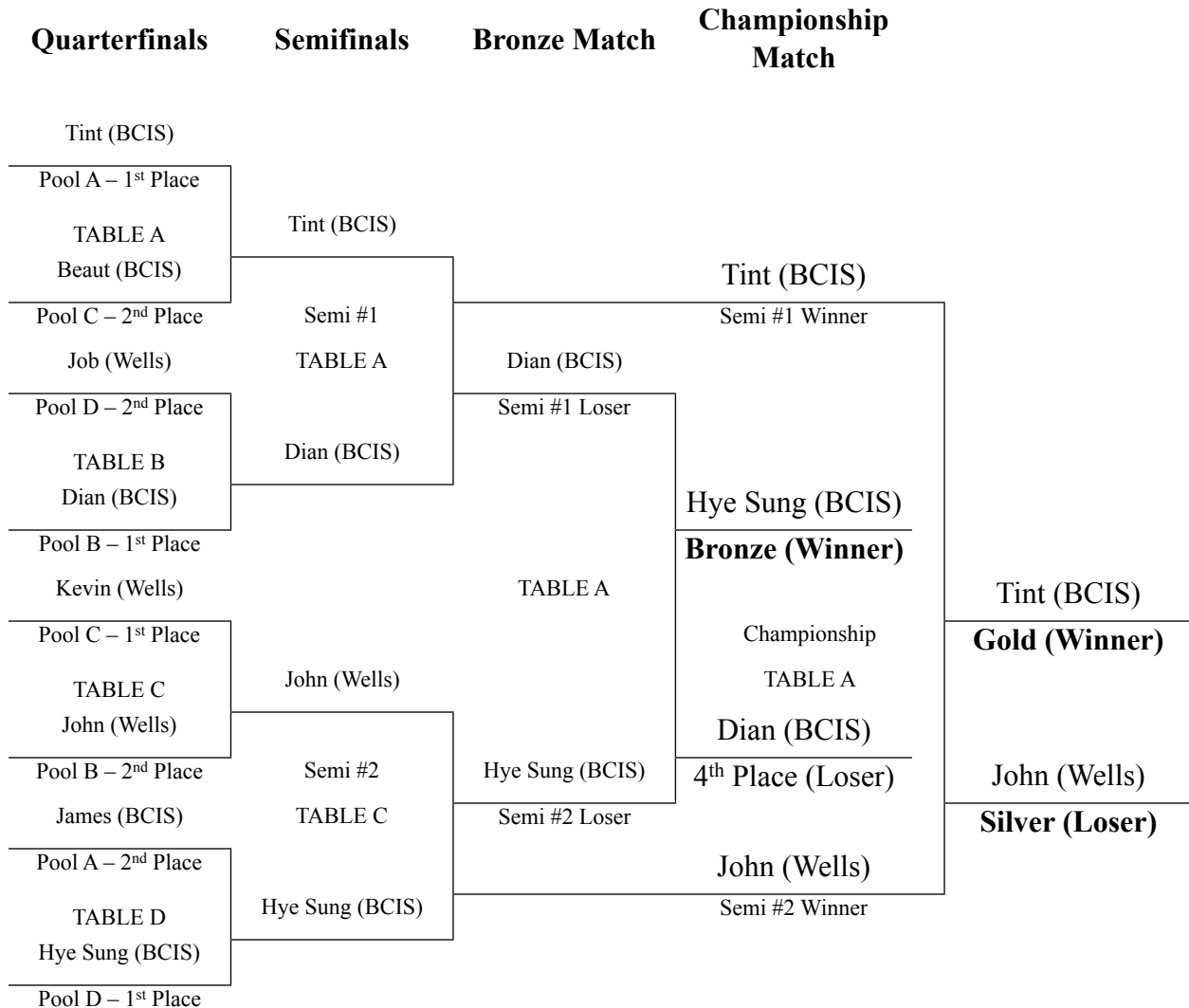
